



Monitor and Evaluation Report 2020

The Monitor and Evaluation in 2020 could be divided into three sections. The first would be, Pre-lockdown, January to the end of March. During Pre-lockdown we had workshops as normal, with the children coming to the workshop venue.

The second, Lockdown, from April to the end of September, the activity packs were distributed at De Kop and children took the packs home with them.

The last part, The Happiness Project, was from October to February 2021, the end of the financial year. These packs were distributed through our facilitator who is a resident at De Kop.

The total number of children that worked with The Children's Book Network material, comes to 10 926.
